Floral sensory impressions that we pick up right outside our door inspire food and beverage manufacturers to develop new products. Not only teas and yoghurt drinks benefit from flavours like nettle, clover or apple blossom. Confectionery, desserts and many other applications are also increasingly relying on regional botanical notes.

Unfortunately, wildflowers and wild herbs are difficult to obtain because they are not cultivated. Therefore, we have set ourselves the task of developing exciting new floral flavours in addition to the well-known varieties such as lavender, rose and rosemary, which deliver the soothing taste experience of native wild plants without the need for costly raw material sourcing. In culinary terms, flowers and herbs can be combined in a variety of ways, e.g. with fruits, spices or brown notes such as chocolate. Peach, for example, harmonises wonderfully with marigold. The same applies to rhubarb and cornflower. However, wildflowers and herbs are also outstanding as a flavouring component by themselves.


As the name suggests, the profile of a fresh, green apple dominates in the apple blossom.

#### From meadow to plate


Clover is usually an uninvited guest in ornamental lawns, yet the edible flowers have a lot of potential.

#### Blue and distinctive


European consumers recognise cornflowers as bright blue colour splashes in intentionally seeded bee pastures on roadside verges.

#### Not just for skin care


Marigold is already widely used in cosmetics. Let us show you how it can also be effective as a flavour. A unique taste experience awaits you.


Apart from the leaves, the aromatic blossoms of sage have long been appreciated in cooking

## Popularity confirmed by consumers

Innovations are important for manufacturers to position themselves in the market, but ultimately consumers decide on the success of a product. Therefore we conducted a customer survey to follow up on our thoughts.

51 people of our internal panel were asked about the taste of a near-water drink with wildflower flavours. The clear favourite was our apple blossom flavour, the fruity components combined with floral notes won over the majority of our testers. But all types find their champions.

## **Popularity confirmed by consumers**

Our tasting clearly showed that floral and perfumy notes, such as the marigold flavour, are more popular with female consumers. Among men, clover found increased favour as a flavouring for near-water. It was described as refreshing and sparkling.

The survey was limited to Germany where floral flavours are not very common. The innovative products aroused interest and found approval. Combinations of our wildflowers with fruity flavours promise further growing acceptance. Taste as customers appreciate it - well known, but with an innovative, inspiring accent for conscious wellness moments!
